#### **NOMINATIONS**

What are Nominations? Credit Unions have a nomination facility whereby if you are over 16 years of age, you can nominate someone to receive the funds in your credit union accounts upon your death. You may nominate a person(s) of choice to receive your property presently up to a maximum value of 423,000. Any amount in a years of

amount in excess of €23,000 will form part of your estate.

You may change the details of your nomination as often as you like. A completed nomination must be

signed and witnessed. Ask in the office and a staff member will help you complete the relevant form and witness your signature. The most recent nomination is the valid nomination.
