the appetite and growth of our current account product. We are now also in a position to offer current accounts to anyone over 12 years of age. This is another huge milestone in the provision of services across all the ages and in particular our teenage and student members.

Due to demand and price increases across the construction sector, we increased our Home Improvement Loan product ceiling to €80,000. In September we introduced a very competitive Green Loan to our suite of loan products. This Green loan is one of the most competitive offerings in the market and is already gaining interest and use. We also enhanced our Community Loan product and we will be communicating these improvements in the new vear.

Killarney Credit Union donated over €34,000 to various local clubs, organisations, community initiatives and schools in the last year. We take great pride in supporting local initiatives and value the support we receive in return.

Credit Unions in Ireland won the Cxi award for Customer Service for a record 8th year in a row. This accolade is an endorsement of the sentiment credit unions hold in the population as a whole.

To this end we are currently preparing and finalising our strategic plan for the coming three years. 
In conclusion I would like to thank all our members for your continued support, business & loyalty throughout 2022 and we look forward to continued service through 2023.
